## SS10: Geography Unit One Pager

A ONE-PAGER is a written and graphic interpretation of a concept or topic presented on a SINGLE sheet of paper. It should highlight the thoughts and understanding of the information. It will be a reference for reviewing information. One entire side should be covered with information. Your Name and Block should be written on the BACK of the paper.

## **Required Information:**

- 1) TITLE DESCRIBING THE CONCEPT OR TOPIC: UNDERSTANDING AND PREPARING FOR THE "BIG ONE"
- 2) PRESCRIBED LEARNING OUTCOME: Developing skills and processes of Social Studies
- 3) A large DIAGRAM with a BORDER The Diagram should be colored and Labeled.
- 4) A CAPTION explaining the diagram below the diagram. The caption must summarize the diagram's key concept.
- 5) A QUOTE from the textbook or other sources pertaining to the concept or Topic.
- 6) A SUMMARY of at least 8 sentences explaining the major concepts of the reading or PLO. Your summary must include at least 5 KEY VOCABULARY TERMS highlighted.
- 7) QUESTION BOX: Inside the Question box must be at least 2 questions for further study, and an explanation of WHY you chose that question.
- 8) Something CREATIVE: Your choice, showing or explaining how the information relates to some aspect of your life. Possible ideas are poems (acrostics, haiku, etc.), drawings, etc.
