Sample Provincial Exam Essay-Response Questions

For the provincial exam, students are asked to answer two essay-response questions. Students can practise their exam skills by answering two of the following essay-response questions:

- 1. To what extent are a citizen's rights and freedoms protected by the Charter of Rights and Freedoms? (Politics & Government)
- 2. Discuss the process by which Canada gained autonomy from Britain. Use examples from the period 1914 to 2000. (*Autonomy & International Involvement*)
- 3. To what extent have relations between French and English Canada changed in the period 1914 to 2000? (Society & Identity)
- 4. To what extent were governments successful in dealing with the effects of the Great Depression? (Society & Identity)
- 5. To what extent is the developed world responsible for impoverishment in developing countries? (*Human Geography*)
- 6. Discuss how Canadians can take responsibility in reducing environmental damage to the land, air, and water in this country. (*Human Geography*)
